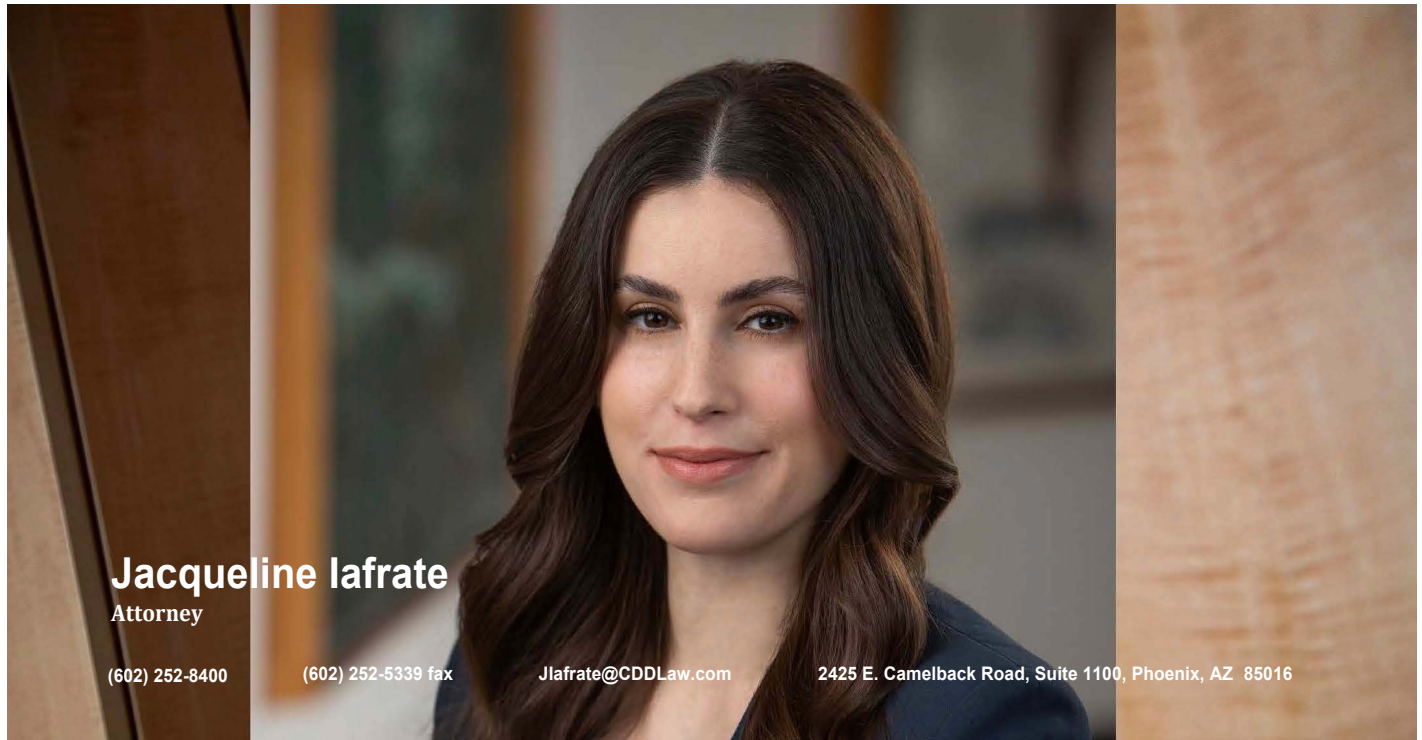




BIOGRAPHY
